School will close Wednesday 21st December at 3.30pm and re-open on Monday 9th January 2017. After School Club will still run as normal on our last day.



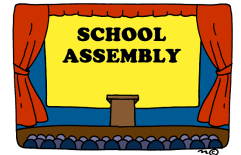
Brass Band
