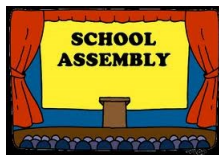


## Dear Parents / Carers

Your child's 'Interim Progress Review' will be sent home with your child this week. The report is a visual indicator of how your child is performing in relation to 'Year Related Expectations' and effort in English, Maths and Science, the core subjects of the national curriculum. We recognise that this is far from all that your child does on a daily basis in school and will not reflect all their gifts and talents but can be used as a tool for discussion at the next parents evening on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> November.



After-school club will be introducing an online check-out system in the next half term. This will hopefully make the process more efficient as it will enable after-school club bills to be calculated directly and then put into our online payment system. It will also allow for different members of the family to sign the children out.

## **Car-Park Issues**

Several parents have raised concerns about the arrangements for collecting children from after-school club. Please be aware that if you drive up to the top car park to collect children that there maybe children walking down the path and crossing the access road at the bottom using the designated crossing point. Please be mindful of this when driving up the access road to pick children up from after-school club.



Also, we are aware that some parents are still dropping children off in the top staff car park in the morning, particularly if they are late for school. This is causing issues for families with children who have disabilities or parents who have disabilities. The staff car park, which has the disabled access, is quite small and families who need to use the disabled access are either prevented from accessing or leaving the disabled spaces. Even if you are a little late, please drop your child off in the car park at the bottom and encourage your child to walk up to school. They will be welcomed through the main office. Please also be mindful of this when collecting from school.
