A much better week on the challenge with Year 6 being this week's winners. The schools current outstanding lunch bill today is £424.09 compared to last week's £858.69. This is made up of:

**Year 6** £126.30 (made up from 10 debtors) — a drop of £265.55 or a massive 67.77% change

**Year 5** £87.61 (made up from 9 debtors) — a drop of £84.30 or a 49% change

**Year 4** £116.48 (made up from 14 debtors) — a drop of £60.50 or a 34.2% change

**Year 3** £93.70 (made up from 9 debtors) — a drop of £44.10 or a 32% change
