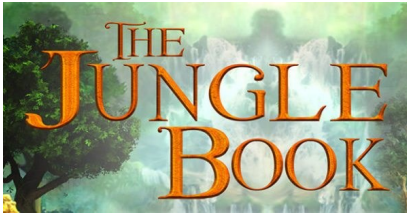


Weekly Update 19th January 2018

Children need to wear a plain white T-shirt along with normal uniform if they did not order a printed Young Voices one.

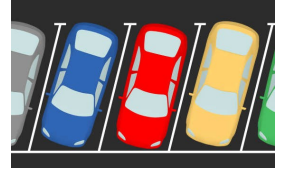
INDOOR ATHLETICS
