## UNIFORM

Following lengthy consultation the new uniform has been decided by school. There is no change to skirts or pinafores. Bespoke jumpers and cardigans with logos, made from wool/acrylic blends that are easy care, will replace the sweatshirt style of jumper and cardigan. White pointed collar shirts will replace white polo shirts / blouses. A tartan Velcro tie should be worn by all Reception – Year 5 pupils unless they are wearing a pinafore / summer dress. Year 6 will retain their unique tie. Years 5 and 6 will also retain the option of a blazer.



There are 2 suppliers available with differing price ranges – Skip to School, 32/34 Water Street, Skipton & Moonline, 37 Standish Street, Burnley. We are still sourcing a summer dress.
