## Christmas Tree Decorating



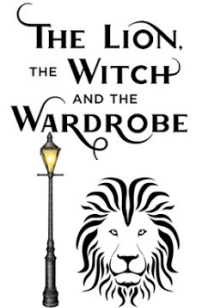
