



RE: Consultation on admission arrangements

Dear interested party,

I am writing to notify you of the consultation on the school's 2026 – 27 admissions policy. The consultation period will run from 25th November 2024 until 13th January 2025; during this time, parents and other key stakeholders are invited to express their views and any concerns about the admission arrangements at Laneshaw Bridge Primary School.

In accordance with the DfE's 2021 statutory 'School Admissions Code' guidance, as a school we must consult on our admission arrangements when changes are proposed, and at least once every seven years. For this reason, a consultation is currently being held to meet the statutory duty in all of the four schools in the Pennine Trust.

In accordance with statutory DfE guidance, the consultation will run for at least six weeks and, as an interested party at Laneshaw Bridge Primary School we are keen to hear your views on the current admission arrangements; therefore, we invite you to participate in the consultation if you have any comments regarding the matter.
